



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2018 - 02

**FURTHER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL
(MPOC) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN**

WHEREAS, Article 185, Rule 23 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that a Local Peace and Order Council be established in every municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to further reorganize the existing Municipal Peace and Order Council previously reorganized by virtue of Executive Order No. 2016-21 pursuant to Executive No. 773, considering the change in the composition of some of the members thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JUANITO H. SANTIAGO, Municipal Mayor of Marilao, Bulacan, by the virtue of power vested in me by laws, do hereby **ORDER**:

Section 1. REORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL.
The MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (MPOC, for brevity) in the Municipal Government of Marilao, Bulacan, is hereby further reorganized, to be composed of the following:

Section 2. DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MPOC. The MPOC shall perform the following duties, functions and responsibilities:

- a. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
- b. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including anti-insurgency measures;





- c. Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
- d. Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to the Communist rebels;
- e. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural of indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them from the Communist rebels "Agitate/Arouse, Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organization works; and
- f. Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or NPOC.

Section 3. DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat shall perform the following duties, functions and responsibilities:

- a. Handle the administrative and technical activities of the MPOC;
- b. Prepare plans and programs for the consideration of the MPOC;
- c. Supervise, direct and monitor, for the MPOC, implementation of approved policies, plans and programs;
- d. Undertake liaisoning and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government;
- e. Provide a forum for the inter-disciplinary dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order; and
- f. Provide such other assistance as may be required by the MPOC.

Section 4. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office of the members of the MPOC shall be until noon of **June 30, 2019**. However, members of the MPOC may act in hold-over capacity until their successors shall be duly appointed and qualified.

Section 5. FILLING IN VACANCY. Any vacancy in the membership of the MPOC shall automatically be filled in by the successor duly elected or appointed by the respective organization to which he or she belongs, if applicable, and who shall serve only for the unexpired term. The concerned organization must submit the name of the successor to the Office of the Mayor, the DILG-Marilao and the Sangguniang Bayan for their information and guidance. The name of the successor will be *ipso facto* included in Section 1 of this Order.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other rules, regulations and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take immediately.
