**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT THROUGH THE HONORABLE BENJAMIN E. DIOKNO, SECRETARY, MABINI HALL, MALACANAN PALACE, MANILA, PHILIPPINES TO PLEASE ALLOCATE FUND AMOUNTING TO FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP 5,000,000.00) FOR THE PROPOSED ROAD UPGRADING AND CANAL WORKS OF ROADS IN DE CASTRO SUBDIVISION, BARANGAY IBAYO, MARILAO, BULACAN.**

**WHEREAS**, submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan is a letter requesting this August Body to pass a resolution earnestly requesting the Department of Budget and Management through the Honorable Benjamin E. Diokno, Secretary, Mabini Hall, Malacanan Palace, Manila, Philippines to please allocate fund amounting to Five Million Pesos (PHP 5,000,000.00) for the proposed road upgrading and canal works of roads in De Castro Subdivision, Barangay Ibayo, Marilao, Bulacan;

**WHEREAS**, indeed this Municipality of Marilao, Bulacan Province, recognizes the significance of the proposed road upgrading and canal works in roads in De Castro Subdivision, Barangay Ibayo as this is a route linking said sitio and as access road to the adjacent Barangays;
