SECTION 3. INTEGRATION WITH THE MUNICIPAL HEALTH SYSTEM.

To align with the UHC mandates and ensure continuity of care, all medical missions and PhilHealth YAKAP Registration activities must:

- a. **Submit Registration Data.**
All registration forms, patient encounter forms, and related documentation shall be submitted to the MHO for encoding into the Local Health Information System, consistent with UHC data management protocols.
- b. **Ensure Navigator Linkage.**
Event organizers shall clearly identify the Municipal Health Center as the navigator or designated referral facility for residents requiring follow-up care, continuity of medication, laboratory diagnostics, or other forms of primary care management.
- c. **Observe UHC-Consistent Provider Assignment.**
Organizers shall not assign residents to external primary care networks without coordination with the MHO to prevent fragmentation of patient records and to maintain territorial health accountability under the UHC Act.

SECTION 4. SANCTIONS.

Failure to comply with the mandatory acknowledgment requirement and registration protocols shall constitute grounds for the immediate cancellation or stoppage of the event and may result in denial of future event permits requested by the organizing entity or its representatives.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.

This Order shall take effect immediately.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. JS2026-04

AN ORDER MANDATING COORDINATION WITH AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT BY THE MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICER (MHO) OF MARILAO, BULACAN PRIOR TO THE CONDUCT OF MEDICAL MISSIONS AND PHILHEALTH YAKAP REGISTRATION ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF MARILAO

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act, mandates that all Filipinos shall be automatically included in the National Health Insurance Program and enjoins local government units to ensure a coordinated and continuous health care delivery system and the registration of every Filipino to a primary care provider;

WHEREAS, the PhilHealth YAKAP (Yaman ng Kalusugan Program) serves as the primary mechanism for implementing the Out-Patient Health Benefit Package, requiring systematic PhilHealth registration and linkage of residents to accredited primary care providers;

WHEREAS, to comply with the mandates of RA 11223 and to prevent fragmentation of care, all medical missions and PhilHealth YAKAP registration activities undertaken within the Municipality of Marilao must contribute to the integrity of local long-term health records, the establishment of primary care provider assignment, and compliance with the UHC Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);

WHEREAS, Section 6.6 of the UHC IRR states that:

“Every Filipino shall register with a public or private primary care provider of choice...”

and Section 6.7 further mandates that:

“LGUs, with the assistance from DOH and PhilHealth, shall register their respective constituents to a primary care provider...” and shall ensure the data management, guidelines, and processes for such primary care registration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JEMINA M. SY, Municipal Mayor of Marilao, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. MANDATORY COORDINATION.

All organizers of medical missions and PhilHealth YAKAP registration activities operating within the Municipality of Marilao shall secure prior acknowledgment from the Municipal Health Officer (MHO) at least fifteen (15) days before the scheduled event through a written Letter of Acknowledgment issued by the MHO.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF UHC IRR.

This Order expressly adopts and enforces the relevant provisions of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 11223, particularly Sections 6.6 and 6.7 on Primary Care Provider Registration and Accountability for Registration, as integral to all health-related outreach activities conducted within the municipality.
