WHEREAS, the Office of the Municipal Mayor presented to this August Body a Letter of Endorsement entitled "*A Resolution authorizing the Municipal Mayor, Honorable Atty. Jemina M. Sy, for and on behalf of the Municipal Government of Marilao, to request financial and technical assistance from the Department of Tourism (DOT) for the implementation of the Proposed 2026 Tourism Development Programs, particularly the "Marilao Heritage, Faith & Flavors Trail" and "Tatak Marilao: Gastronomy Micro-Enterprise Accelerator," in line with the DOT's Food and Gastronomy Tourism Roadmap (2024-2029) in the Municipality of Marilao, Province of Bulacan.*" for its appropriate action;

WHEREAS, the Department of Tourism (DOT) has launched the Food and Gastronomy Tourism Roadmap 2024-2029, to encourage Local Government Units (LGUs) to transform the public markets and local food cultures into tourism products;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Marilao proposes two (2) flagship projects for 2026 as listed below, that aim to harness its rich culinary heritage, religious tourism assets, and vibrant local food economy:

1. Marilao Heritage, Faith & Flavors Trail, and
2. Tatak Marilao: Gastronomy Micro-Enterprise Accelerator

WHEREAS, both proposed programs are aligned with DOT's five strategic pillars: cultural preservation, market tourism development, stakeholder capacity building, destination enhancement, and branding.

WHEREAS, the said projects are expected to generate inclusive local economic growth, increase visitor arrivals and spending, uplift food micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), and establish Marilao as a recognized Gastronomy and Cultural Destination in Central Luzon;

WHEREAS, both projects are designed to be fundable under the DOT's Food and Gastronomy Tourism Roadmap, eligible for support from DTI, DA, TIEZA, and other national or private partners and it will help establish Marilao, Bulacan as Central Luzon's emerging Gastronomy and Faith Tourism Destination by 2026;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Vanessa Valdez-Seminiano, duly seconded by Honorable Maria Luisa I. Silvestre and upon unanimous vote.

BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve the above-mentioned resolution of this Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Marilao, Bulacan.
