**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HONORABLE ATTY. JEMINA M. SY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MARILAO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) FIELD OFFICE III RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RISK RESILIENCY PROGRAM – CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND MITIGATION (RRP-CCAM) PROJECT LAWA (LOCAL ADAPTATION TO WATER ACCESS) AND PROJECT BINHI (BREAKING INSUFFICIENCY THROUGH NUTRITIOUS HARVEST FOR THE IMPOVERISHED) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Municipal Mayor presented to this Body a Letter of Endorsement entitled, “A Resolution authorizing the Municipal Mayor, Honorable Atty. Jemina M. Sy, for and on behalf of the Municipal Government of Marilao, to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Field Office III relative to the implementation of the Risk Resiliency Program – Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (RRP-CCAM) Project LAWA (Local Adaptation to Water Access) and Project BINHI (Breaking Insufficiency Through Nutritious Harvest for the Impoverished) in the Municipality of Marilao, Province of Bulacan.” for appropriate action;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121 mandates the DSWD as the Vice-Chairperson for Disaster Response of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC). Section 2 of the said law provides among others, maximum care, assistance and services to individuals and families affected by disaster, implement preparedness and emergency rehabilitation projects to lessen the impact of disaster and facilitate resumption of normal social and economic activities;

**WHEREAS**, Local Government Units are mandated under the Local Government Code (Republic Act No. 7160) to address the needs of their constituents and empower the people through direct participation in governance by allowing them the widest possible space to participate in, decide on, initiate, implement, and innovate development activities that address their identified needs;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Marilao is deeply dedicated to safeguarding its citizens from the effects of disasters, calamities, and other catastrophic events that threaten lives, property, and livelihoods by implementing a disaster risk education and management strategy focused on strengthening community resilience and ensuring timely and responsive services for the people;

**WHEREAS**, in response to increasing risk and exposure to hazards, exacerbated by climate change including the El Niño/ La Niña Phenomenon there is a need to implement programs that will ensure maximum care, assistance and services to individuals and families to lessen the impact of disaster and facilitate resumption of normal and social and economic activities;

**WHEREAS**, by linking anticipatory action to existing social protection systems to roll out a range of early actions, the DSWD in partnership with the Local Government Units (LGUs) and other stakeholders mandates to implement the interventions, programs and projects through Risk Resiliency Program – Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (RRP-CCAM) Project LAWA (Local Adaptation to Water Access) and BINHI (Breaking Insufficiency Through Nutritious Harvest for the Impoverished), to help the communities adapt and mitigate the effects of the El Niño Phenomenon and improve their access to water;

**WHEREAS**, the goal of the said projects is to strengthen resilience, adaptive capacity and response capabilities of poor, vulnerable, marginalized families and communities from the impact of climate-related hazards and disaster risk by providing additional income support, ensure food security through efficient construction and/or rehabilitation of water pond/reservoir infrastructure, and other natural assets that maximizes economic and environmental benefits of natural resources, and strengthen partnership with LGUs communities and other stakeholders through coordination, collaboration, and cooperation;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Vanessa Valdez-Seminiano, duly seconded by Hon. Juanito H. Santiago, and upon unanimous vote,

**BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to approve the above-mentioned Resolution of this Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Marilao, Bulacan;

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, that all concerned municipal departments and barangay councils are encouraged to actively participate in and extend assistance for the successful conduct of the said activity.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Municipal Mayor and all other concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
