EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. JS2025-38A

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DESIGNATING A TEMPORARY BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION FACILITY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates local government units to promote the general welfare, including the preservation of peace and order and the protection of public health and safety;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9165, or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, provides for a comprehensive and balanced approach to addressing the drug problem, including treatment, rehabilitation, and reintegration of drug dependents and reformists;

WHEREAS, the national government, through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and partner agencies, promotes the implementation of community-based drug rehabilitation programs under the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy (PADS);

WHEREAS, pursuant to DILG guidelines on the establishment of Balay Silangan Reformation Facilities, local government units are encouraged to designate facilities that will serve as reformation centers for drug reformists undergoing community-based intervention;

WHEREAS, the Balay Silangan Program aims to transform drug reformists into self-sufficient, law-abiding, and productive members of society through holistic interventions, including spiritual formation, values development, and livelihood support;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Municipality of Marilao to designate a temporary Balay Silangan facility to ensure the immediate implementation of reformation programs while longer-term arrangements are being developed;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC) serves as the primary body responsible for the coordination and implementation of anti-illegal drug programs at the municipal level;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JEMINA M. SY, Municipal Mayor of Marilao, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by pertinent laws, do hereby ORDER:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF TEMPORARY BALAY SILANGAN FACILITY

A temporary Balay Silangan Reformation Facility is hereby designated in the Municipality of Marilao with the following details:

Name of Facility	: Bantay Kalikasan Multipurpose Hall
Location	: Tabon Creek, Brgy. Nagbalon, Marilao, Bulacan
Managing Office	: Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC), through its Focal Person, Mr. Reymond Allan O. Santos

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The Balay Silangan Facility shall serve as a community-based reformation center for drug reformists, providing structured interventions aimed at behavioral change, moral recovery, and reintegration into society.

SECTION 3. PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

The Balay Silangan Facility shall implement programs consistent with national guidelines, including but not limited to:

- a. Spiritual formation and values development
- b. Counseling and psychosocial support
- c. Livelihood and skills training
- d. Health and wellness activities
- e. Community service and civic engagement

SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION

The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC) shall exercise overall supervision over the Balay Silangan Facility. The MADAC Focal Person shall oversee its day-to-day operations, including program implementation, coordination, and reporting.

SECTION 5. SUPPORT FROM LOCAL OFFICES

All municipal departments and sections, including barangays, are hereby enjoined to provide the necessary support and assistance for the effective implementation of this Executive Order.

SECTION 6. INTER-AGENCY COORDINATION

The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC), through the Balay Silangan Facility, shall coordinate and collaborate with concerned national government agencies and other stakeholders for technical assistance and program support, including but not limited to:

- a. **Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)** - for policy guidance and program monitoring;
- b. **Philippine National Police (PNP)** - for referral of drug reformists and support in maintaining peace and order;
- c. **Department of Health (DOH)** - for health services and medical support;
- d. **Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)** - for social services and counseling interventions;
- e. **Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)** - for skills training and certification programs; and
- f. **Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (BADACs)** - for identification, referral, and community-level monitoring of beneficiaries.

SECTION 7. FUNDING

Funding requirements for the implementation of this program shall be sourced from available municipal funds, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
