### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. JS2026-62

#### AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ACTIVATING THE CRISIS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN

**WHEREAS**, His Excellency Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr., President of the Philippines, has declared a State of National Energy Emergency, requiring a coordinated and immediate response from all levels of government;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has directed all Local Government Units to ensure preparedness, resource management, and continuity of essential services during the energy emergency;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to activate existing local mechanisms to effectively respond to potential disruptions in power supply, essential services, and public safety;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. JS2026-11 reorganizing the Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC) provides for the creation of a Crisis Management Committee under Section 7.4, with defined duties and functions under Section 9;

**WHEREAS**, the activation of the Crisis Management Committee is necessary to ensure a whole-of-government, coordinated, and responsive approach to the current situation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JEMINA M. SY**, Municipal Mayor of Marilao, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by pertinent laws, do hereby ORDER:

#### SECTION 1. ACTIVATION

The **Crisis Management Committee (CMC)** of the Municipality of Marilao is hereby **activated effective immediately** to oversee, coordinate, and implement all necessary measures in response to the State of National Energy Emergency.

### SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

The Crisis Management Committee shall perform the duties and functions provided under Section 9 of Executive Order No. JS2026-11, including but not limited to:

1. Mobilizing available resources through inter-agency coordination;
2. Coordinating all crisis management efforts within the Municipality;
3. Ensuring that operational demands during crisis situations are met;
4. Establishing communication systems for timely dissemination of information;
5. Overseeing preparedness, response, and post-action assessment activities;

6. Implementing and monitoring mandatory energy conservation measures within all municipal buildings and public facilities;
7. Acting as the primary liaison with MERALCO and other energy providers to coordinate rotating brownouts and priority restoration for critical facilities such as hospitals and water pumping stations; and
8. Performing such other functions as may be directed by higher authorities

### SECTION 4. DIRECTIVES TO ALL OFFICES

All departments, offices, and units of the Municipal Government are hereby directed to:

- a. Extend full cooperation and align all actions with the directives of the Crisis Management Committee;
- b. Ensure readiness of personnel, equipment, and logistical requirements; and
- c. Provide necessary reports, data, and support as may be required.

### SECTION 5. SECRETARIAT SUPPORT

The MPOC Secretariat, as established under Section 3 of Executive Order No. JS2026-11, shall serve as the Secretariat for the Crisis Management Committee to handle documentation, coordination, and reporting requirements.

### SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE

All other orders, rules, regulations, and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

### SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect immediately.
