A ORDINANCE EXEMPTING SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWDs) FROM THE PAYMENT OF PARKING FEES IN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND OTHER SIMILAR PLACES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 994, otherwise known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010, mandates the State to prioritize the welfare, protection, and benefits of senior citizens;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10754 expanded the privileges and benefits of Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), including access and mobility-related accommodations;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Marilao, recognizes the policy of the state to prioritize the welfare of the senior citizens PWDs

WHEREAS, senior citizens and PWDs often face physical, medical, and financial challenges that necessitate reasonable assistance and incentives from both government and private establishments;

WHEREAS, parking fees impose an additional burden on senior citizens and PWDs who regularly visit hospitals, clinics, government offices, malls, and other essential service areas,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance intends to alleviate the financial burden and enhance accessibility for these sectors of the community,

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) empowers local government units to enact ordinances that promote the general welfare of their constituents;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Harvey C. Mediante duly seconded by Hon. Wilfredo D. Diaz, and upon unanimous vote of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan present:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 12th Sangguniang Bayan ng Marilao of that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Parking Exemption Ordinance for Senior Citizens and PWDs of the Municipality of Marilao."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. - It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Marilao to protect and promote the rights and welfare of senior citizens and PWDs by providing reasonable privileges that enhance accessibility, mobility, and economic relief.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to all business establishments, including but not limited to:

- a. Shopping malls,
- b. Commercial buildings,
- c. Hospitals and medical facilities,
- d. Hotels,
- e. Supermarkets,
- f. Educational institutions,
- g. Restaurants,
- h. Private owned parking facilities open to the public, and
- i. Other similar establishments within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Marilao.

SECTION 4. PARKING FEE EXEMPTION. The following shall be entitled to free parking privileges under this Ordinance provided that:

- a. Senior Citizens who are residents of the Municipality of Marilao. (for Senior Citizens any Valid ID, will be accepted, provided that the ID must include the Address and Date of Birth;
- b. Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) who are holders of a valid PWD ID issued by the Persons with Disabilities Affairs Office (PDAO) in the Municipality of Marilao.
- c. The Senior Citizens or PWD is the driver or passenger of the vehicle; and
- d. A valid ID is presented upon entry of exit.

SECTION 5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF ESTABLISHMENTS. All covered establishments are required to:

- a. Clearly display notices informing the public of parking fee exemption granted under this Ordinance;
- b. Instruct parking personnel regarding proper implementation; and
- c. Ensure that no senior citizens or PWD is denied the privilege herein granted.

SECTION 6. PROHIBITED ACTS. It shall be unlawful for any establishments or its personnel to:

- a. Refuse or fail to grant parking fee exemption to qualified senior citizens or PWDs;
- b. Impose conditions or requirements beyond those stated in this Ordinance; or
- c. Harass, embarrass, or discriminate against senior citizens or PWDs availing of the exemption.

SECTION 7. PENALTIES. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

| a. First Offense: | Fine of One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00) |
| b. Second Offense: | Fine of Two Thousand Pesos (₱2,000.00) |
| c. Third and Succeeding Offenses: | Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) and possible suspension or revocation of business permit, subject to existing laws and regulations. |

If the violator is an employee, both the employee and the establishment owners or operator shall be held liable.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY – The Municipal Mayor through the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), and other concerned offices, shall be responsible for the implementation and monitoring of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected and shall continue to be effective.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. – This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication or posting in conspicuous places within the Municipality of Marilao.
