A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HONORABLE ATTY. JEMINA M. SY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MARILAO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF MIGRANT WORKERS (DMW), THE OVERSEAS WORKERS WELFARE ADMINISTRATION (OWWA), THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE), AND THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (TESDA) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAMS AND SERVICES PROMOTING THE RIGHTS AND WELFARE OF MIGRANT WORKERS AND THEIR FAMILIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, PROVINCE OF BULACAN.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Mayor, Honorable Atty. Jemina M. Sy, submitted to this August Body a Letter of Endorsement entitled "*A Resolution authorizing the Municipal Mayor Hon. Atty. Jemina M. Sy, for and on behalf of the Municipal Government of Marilao, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Migrant Workers (DMW), the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) to implement programs and services to promote the rights and Welfare of the Public, migrant workers and members of their families in the Municipal Government of Marilao, Province of Bulacan.*" for appropriate action;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Marilao recognizes the significant contribution of migrant workers to the local and national economy and acknowledges the need to protect and promote their rights and welfare;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, grants local government units the authority to promote the general welfare of their constituents and to enter into agreements with national government agencies and other entities to implement programs and services beneficial to the public;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8042, otherwise known as the "*Migrant Workers and Overseas Filipinos Act of 1995*," as amended by Republic Act No. 10022, mandates the State to afford full protection to labor, local and overseas, and promote the welfare of migrant workers and their families;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11641, otherwise known as the "*Department of Migrant Workers Act*," created the Department of Migrant Workers (DMW) to protect the rights and promote the welfare of overseas Filipino workers and strengthen coordination with other government agencies and local government units;

WHEREAS, the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) are mandated government agencies that provide programs and services such as welfare assistance, employment facilitation, reintegration support, and skills development for migrant workers and their families;

WHEREAS, as part of its mandate, the DMW undertakes to develop and support programs and projects for livelihood, entrepreneurship, savings, investments, and financial literacy for returning Filipino migrant workers and members of their families in coordination with relevant stakeholders, service providers, and international organizations for the purpose of implementing the full-cycle national reintegration program for OFWs, which shall cover the different dimensions of support needed by the OFW such as economic, social, psychological, gender-responsive, and cultural support which shall be embedded in all stages of migration for work beginning from pre-deployment, on-site during employment, and upon return;

WHEREAS, the partnership between the Municipal Government of Marilao and the aforementioned agencies aims to strengthen programs and services that support migrant workers and their families through capacity building, employment opportunities, reintegration programs, and social protection;

WHEREAS, the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) will formalize the collaboration among the concerned agencies and the Municipal Government of Marilao to effectively implement programs and initiatives that will benefit migrant workers and their families in the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Maria Luisa I. Silvestre, duly seconded by Hon. Juanito H. Santiago, and upon unanimous vote of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan present:

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to authorize the Municipal Mayor, Honorable Atty. Jemina M. Sy, for and in behalf of the Municipal Government of Marilao, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Migrant Workers (DMW), the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) for the implementation of programs and services promoting the rights and welfare of migrant workers and their families in the Municipality of Marilao, Province of Bulacan.
